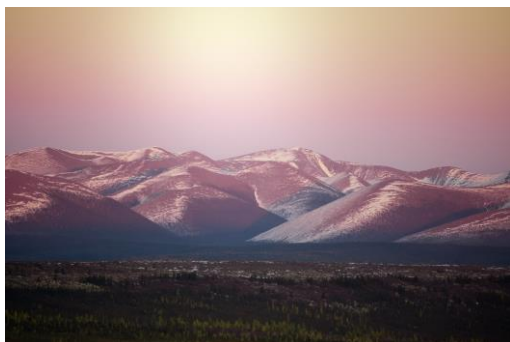

Who are we?

Under the Inuvik Justice Committee, victim services is a free, non-judgmental and confidential service offered in the Beaufort Delta region to victims of crime and tragedy. We provide assistance in many different ways.

Our goals as Victim Services workers is to lessen the immediate impact of crime and tragedy for those who seek our help emotionally and throughout the court process. We're not counsellors but we are a kind ear to listen. We are also a great place to find general information about services available to you within your communities.

The Inuvik Justice Committee (IJC)

The Inuvik Justice Committee is a non-profit organization. In 2001, the Inuvik Justice Committee became the sponsoring organization for Victim Services. The IJC provides various programming and advocacy.



How can we help?

We provide information, emotional support, and referrals for victims of crime and tragedy. You do not need to be a victim of crime to speak with us. In fact, some clients who see us are just in need of emotional or community support due to:

- ◆ Sudden death or suicide of a loved one
- ◆ Community tragedy
- ◆ Disasters (i.e house fire)
- ◆ Motor vehicle accidents
- ◆ Domestic violence or unhealthy relationships
- ◆ Sexual abuse
- ◆ Robbery/break and enter
- ◆ Elder abuse
- ◆ Family or personal mental health concerns

We can assist in a variety of ways

- ♥ Advocate for you and your rights
- ♥ General information about the criminal justice system and how it works
- ♥ Updated information on what is happening with your case in court
- ♥ Help with preparing a Victim Impact Statements, Emergency Protection Orders, Homeless Assistance Fund and various other related court or government documentation
- ♥ Emotional support as you prepare and go through court
- ♥ Referrals to specialized community resources
- ♥ Creating safety plans, or applying of Victims of Crime Emergency Fund for victims of violent crime.
